Rick welcomed attendees and invited each to introduce themselves. Those attending in person were invited to get some lunch.

Guest Speakers from Full Spectrum Psychology were the owners: Kevin Beyerlein and Dr. Aaron Harris. Full Spectrum is in the old CAL Ranch Building at 675 East Anderson in Idaho Falls. Their phone number is 208-432-1976. May change name to Full Spectrum Health and Recovery. The additional building should open around November 1 on John Adams Parkway in Idaho Falls. Adult services and medical services will be in the John Adams building and the youth services and psych testing will be in the Anderson building.

Full Spectrum is a full-service company. Kim Carey runs outpatient services and directs therapists. Also provide psychological services. Have an additional part-time

psychologist. Have additional extenders and looking to do psych testing in Rexburg. Has an FNP and a PA working to provide primary care. Also provide services for kids. Expertise in PTSD and trauma. Will have a second building soon. Work with children, youth, and adults (no limit on age). They are actively looking for providers to add to their team. They have nineteen employees (part and full-time) now and are looking to add at least ten more.

Full Spectrum wants to provide as much as they can to the community. Looking at co-responding with Police and Sheriff's Department for youth and adults. Looking for grant funding right now to be able to fund co-responding. Also work with the 988 hotline and the Crisis Center.

Services provided include:

- Intensive Outpatient Services – Substance Abuse (IOP and PHP)
- Medication-Assisted Treatment
- Medication Management
- Medical and Primary Care
- Psychological Examinations
- Neuropsychological Testing
- Psychotherapy and Counseling
- Case Management and CBRS
- Recovery Coaching
- Peer Support
- Behavioral Intervention (BI)
- Skills Training for Kids (8-17)

PHP Program: In a group for 6 hours in a day.

IOP: 3 hours per day up to 5 days per week

Outpatient: provide peer support, recovery coaching

They take all insurance including Tri-care right now and will go out and get credentialed so they can take any and all insurance. They take Medicare and Medicaid as well. Work with Magellan Funding to help those that are not insured. Also have a sliding fee scale. Work with a couple of interns for more affordable cash pay.

CSP Updates:

- Worked with mayors and cities to bring "Angel" Memorial Events to American Falls, Pocatello, Blackfoot, Idaho Falls, Rigby, Rexburg, and St. Anthony. St. Anthony bench was dedicated last month.
- The seventh annual conference was held on September 19 in Idaho Falls.
- Spud Days parade in Shelley. Also participated in a few other parades in 2025. The last parade of the year is the ISU Homecoming Parade in Pocatello the last Saturday in October.

- Annual Survivors of Suicide Loss dinner the Saturday before Thanksgiving in Idaho Falls. Contact Tina Wheatley for more information. Reservations only due to limited space. Try to keep it at one hundred attendees. 143 have expressed interest this year. Janet Allen will be the keynote speaker at the dinner. Paige Ann will be singing. She appeared on American Idol.
